How to get to Mátrafüred

Assuming you arrive in Hungary by a plane landing in Liszt Ferenc Airport, you have the following choices – as of October 24, 2019– to get to Mátrafüred.



Public transport

As for the public transport in Budapest, you may take the busline **200E** from the airport to Felsőcsatári street and then change there to busline **95** heading to Puskás Ferenc stadium. Once you arrive at the stadium take a walk (about 200 m) from there to the nearby bus stations (Hungária körút 48 / Hungária circuit 48).

It takes about one hour to get from the airport to the bus stations and the tickets cost \sim 1300 HUF (\sim 4 \in).

Please note that you will not be able to pay for the tickets in Euros. Also, feel free to plan alternative routes to the bus stations by using BKK Futár.

At the bus stations there are several direct connections to Mátrafüred every day. It is suggested you take one of these so that you will not have to change buses. For these connections look for buses heading to Bükkszék, Mátraszentimre or Gyöngyös and take off at the Mátrafüred bus station stop. The resort is in walking distance (about 200 m) from there.

You should be able to buy the tickets from the bus driver directly and they cost about 1700 HUF (5 \in) in total.

Although it is only available in Hungarian, you may find useful this page to check departure times of the buses.

<u>Shuttle bus</u>

As an alternative, it is also possible to book a minibus from Liszt Ferenc airport to Mátrafüred directly. For more information, see an example here. On special demand we may be able to organise shuttle buses to take you from the airport to Mátrafüred. However, we cannot cover the costs of this transport.
